S. jurisdiction was thus extended to 200 miles from the U.S. shoreline, and a new fisheries management organization was established. Eight regional fishery management councils were set up to manage fisheries in conjunction with the States and the Department of Commerces National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS). GAO examined the implementation of the Act, with emphasis on the activities of the regional councils and their interactions with NMFS. NMFS and the eight regional councils have done much to achieve successful domestic fisheries management. They are working together toward insuring conservation and realizing the full potential of the Nations fishery resources. FMPs have been developed to provide fisheries management for domestic and foreign fishermen, and demand has been decreased on domestic fish stocks.
